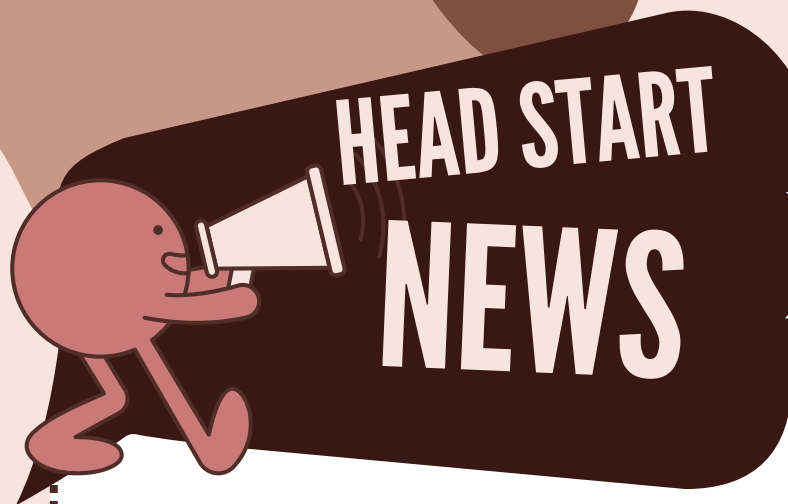

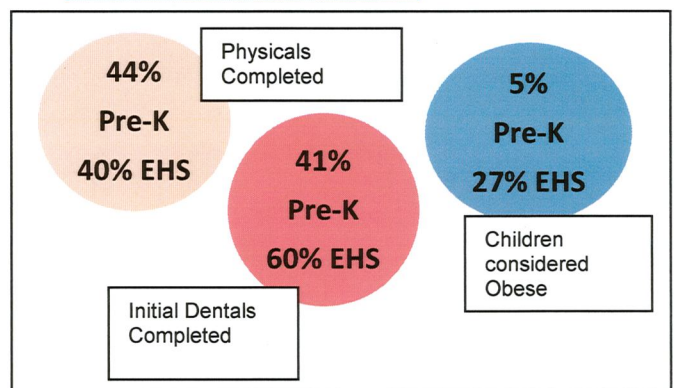

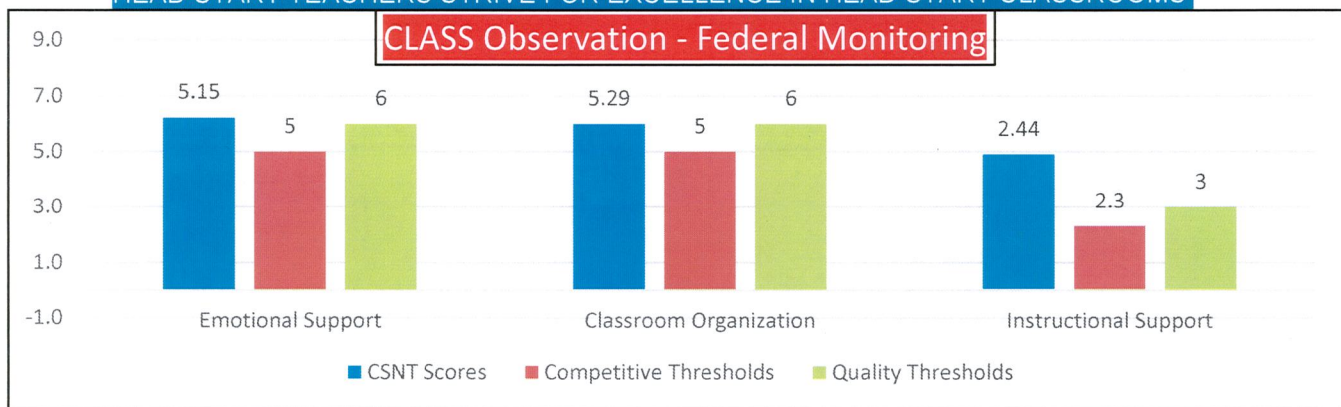

OCTOBER 2025

ENROLLMENT

Head Start reached full enrollment of 465 in September 2025. Current enrollment is at 459 with 6 vacancies. Head Start staff are working to fill all vacancies.

Early Head Start has maintained full enrollment of 16.

Family Engagement Coordinator is completing 100% file checks.

EDUCATION

All teachers have completed their beginning of the year Parent-Teacher Conferences and Circle Assessments.

Education Coordinator is completing the Fall 2025 CLASS observations.

Education Coordinator will complete CLASS Trainer of Trainers in November 2025.

We had one new staff obtain her CDA certification!

HEALTH

All 45-day deadline requirements have been completed (Hearing/Vision)

Dr. Joshua Talley will be on our campuses on Oct. 24 to complete our fall dental clinic.
